How do I know if my application went through?

The web form automatically sends responses to your email once it is completed. We recommend checking the spam folder.

How much does the course cost?

Who is this course intended for?

The course is aimed at public officials and officials responsible for the design, direction, implementation and evaluation of public policies, members of social, academic and academic organizations and movements of MERCOSUR member states and the OAS.

What's the course teaching modality?

The course is entirely in virtual mode. It has a first phase where the modules are developed with their respective contents and a second phase where participants present their final work and receive classes by specialists. Both phases are mandatory to receive certification. In addition, the course will have synchronous classes that will be saved in case it is not possible to establish connection with all participants.

How do I apply to the course?

At what times will synchronous classes take place?

The day and time of the synchronous classes will be sent to you before the course begins. While participation in most classes is required, we will be also recording them for those who are unable to attend.

If I reside in a country that is not a member of the OAS, can I apply for the course?

If you are a national of any of the OAS Member States you can apply, regardless of the current country of residence. In addition, those who are not nationals of a Member State but have legal residence in one of those countries may also apply.

In what languages will the course take place?

Course materials and synchronous classes will be available in Spanish and English. However, participants from Brazil can make their interventions in the forums of participation in their native language.
