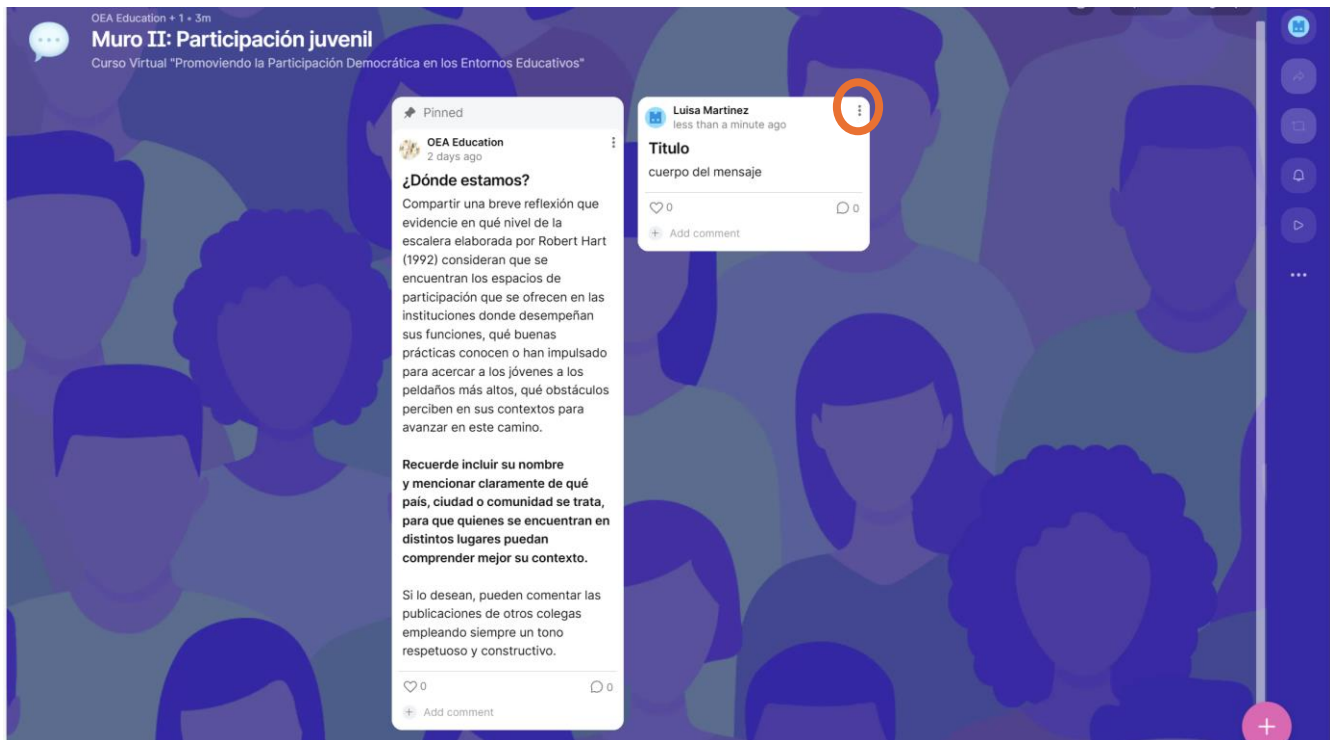


Steps for submitting evidence of your contributions on the discussion walls

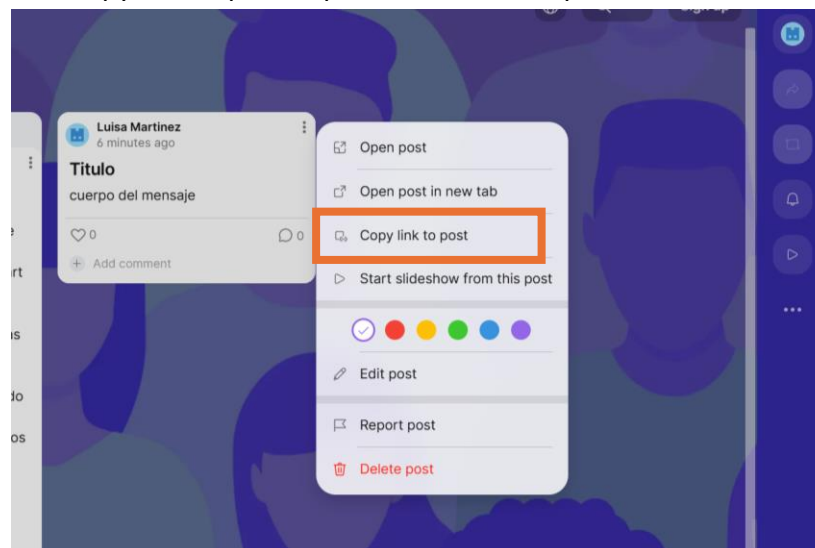
Final assessment – Week 6

As part of the post-training assessment, you must submit evidence of your contributions to the discussion walls.

1. Locate the post you want to share and click on the three vertical dots icon (...) in the upper right corner of the post.



2. Select the “Copy link to post” option from the drop-down menu that pops up.





3. Once you have completed the questions in the post-training evaluation, paste the links to your contributions in the corresponding space. You will find a space to post contributions for each of the four discussion walls. If you do not wish to submit evidence from a wall, please enter N/A in the evaluation.
4. You can paste the link by either right-clicking in the area where you want to paste and selecting “Paste,” or by pressing the **Ctrl + V** key (Windows) or **Cmd + V** key (Mac) to paste.
