REQUEST FROM THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF HUNGARY
TO BE GRANTED THE STATUS OF PERMANENT OBSERVER
TO THE ORGANIZATION

THE PERMANENT COUNCIL OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES,

HAVING SEEN the request presented by the Government of the Republic of Hungary to be granted the status of Permanent Observer to the Organization of American States (CP/doc.2094/90), the information on the Republic of Hungary provided by the General Secretariat (CP/CAJP-788/90), and the report of the Committee on Juridical and Political Affairs on this request (CP/doc.2102/90), and

## CONSIDERING:

That through resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-0/71), the General Assembly established the status of Permanent Observer in the Organization of American States and charged the Permanent Council with establishing the criteria and timeliness to give effect to that provision and implement it; and

That, pursuant to resolution CP/RES. 407 (573/84), any independent State may request the status of Permanent Observer to the Organization, in accordance with resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-0/71),

## RESOLVES:

- 1. To accede to the request from the Government of the Republic of Hungary to be granted the status of Permanent Observer to the Organization of American States in accordance with the terms of resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-0/71) and resolution CP/RES. 407 (573/84) of this Council.
- 2. To invite the Government of the Republic of Hungary to accredit a Permanent Observer to the organs, agencies, and entities of the Organization in accordance with the provisions of operative paragraph 7 of resolution CP/RES. 407 (573/84).

3. To request the Secretary General to report the foregoing to the organs, agencies and entities of the Organization, including the inter-American specialized organizations, when the Government of the Republic of-Hungary has been informed of this decision.
