CP/RES. 562 (857/91)

REQUEST FROM THE GOVERNMENT OF INDIA TO ACCREDIT A PERMANENT OBSERVER TO THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES

THE PERMANENT COUNCIL OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES,

HAVING SEEN;

The request submitted by the Government of India for it to be granted the status of Permanent Observer to the Organization of American States (CP/doc.2154/91); and the report of the Committee on Juridical and Political Affairs on the said request (CP/doc.2178/91), and

CONSIDERING:

That, under resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-0/71), the General Assembly made provision for Permanent Observers to the Organization of American States and entrusted to the Permanent Council the task of defining the criteria and setting the date on which that measure would acquire full force and effect;

That, pursuant to resolution CP/RES. 407 (573/84), any independent State may request status as Permanent Observer to the OAS under resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-0/71),

RESOLVES;

- 1. To honor the request of the Government of India that it be granted status as a Permanent Observer to the Organization of American States pursuant to the terms of resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-0/71) of the General Assembly and resolution CP/RES. 407 (573/84) of this Council.
- 2. To invite the Government of India to accredit a Permanent Observer to the organs, agencies and entities of the Organization, pursuant to operative paragraph 7 of resolution CP/RES. 407 (573/84).

3. To ask the Secretary General to notify the organs, agencies and entities of the Organization, including the specialized inter-American agencies, of the foregoing once the Government of India has been informed of the present decision.
