



## "Inter-American Prize for Innovation in Effective Public Management – 2013"

## **OFFICIAL STATEMENT**

The Department for Effective Public Management of the OAS makes of public knowledge that, on the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> of September, 2013, the assessment meeting of the "Inter-American Prize for Innovation in Effective Public Management, 2013" took place in Washington, DC at the OAS headquarters. The Special Jury was chaired by Dr. Kevin Casas Zamora Secretary for Political Affairs of the OAS, and was composed by: Dr. Regina Pacheco, professor at the Getulio Vargas Foundation – Brazil; Dr. Gregorio Montero, Secretary General of the Latin American Centre for Development Administration - CLAD; Dr. Luis Matos, Director of the Governance Program for Latin America of the Graduate School of Political Management of George Washington University; and Dr. Manuel Villoria, professor at the Ortega y Gasset-Marañón Foundation of Spain and at Rey Juan Carlos University of Madrid, Spain.

This activity was aimed to identify innovative initiatives in public management realized by various public institutions of the Americas, in order to reward, recognize, systematize, encourage and promote them as useful and repeatable experiences. A total of 55 applications have been received, from several public institutions at all administrative levels, involving 13 OAS member states.
