



The Commission", is in charge of prevention and early detection of irregularities within state government institutions, and protection of informants of irregularities and referring notifications to the District Attorney, according to Article 2 @acc.sr



IMPORTANCE

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Reasons



• **Previous Situation:**
Inadequate use of existing
laws

• **Problems Addressed:** Unlawful
enrichment, lack of evidence

• **Benefits:** Improved
identification of corruption
cases, evidence gathering

APPROACH

- Compliance with Article 2 of Anti-Corruption Law
- Activation requirement from IMF Staff-Level Agreement
- Selection procedure for Commission members



Implementation

- **Composition of the Commission**
- **Financial coverage and regulations**
 - **Bylaws and legal positions**

Impact & Expected



- Measurement of success in reducing corruption
- Positive changes in international perceptions
- Reduction of corruption
- Systematic approach
- Transparency and accountability
- Success measured by prosecutions and public perception
